Mon 14	Questacon Excursion: We will be exploring all the interactive exhibitions and experiments at the centre. Have your eyes peered for experiments about H2O so we can create the same learning at our program! Please arrive at the service no later than 9:30am. Enjoy fun activities learning about the different LIFEYCLES that surround us every day.		
Tue 15	In House Workshop from 10:30am: Our loveable larrikin, Neisha Murphy will bring to us The Splish Splashing Circus Spectacular where children will enjoy a show with never-before- seen tricks and stunts followed by an interactive circus workshop. Note: The show is interactive, and children might require a spare change of clothes. It's all about WATER as we explore the significance and versatility of water through art and science, not just bringing life to country but to other cultures around the world.		
Wed 16	Learn about the Australian BILBY and help be a part of its conservation as it slowly declines to the brink of extinction and as a result many other native, endangered species in Australia.		
Thu 17	As EASTER is just around the corner, we will have fun creating EGG-CELLENT craft to give to our friends and family over the holidays.

Tue 22	War Memorial Excursion: Enriching our understanding and knowledge about ANZAC day and exploring themes of bravery, sacrifice and living memory of our service men and women. Children will also be engaged with a Memorial Box at service that includes real and replica uniforms, equipment, artefacts, and more. Please arrive at the service no later than 10am. In commemoration of ANZAC day, the children will make beautiful wreaths to remember our veterans and service personnel as their memories live on.		
Wed 23	In House Workshop from 10:30am: Larry Brandy an Aboriginal Storyteller will be visiting our program to share knowledge and culture about our Aboriginal culture and specifically the Australian native Animals including the Bilby. Cotter, Murrumbidgee, Molongolo do you know all the RIVERS in Ngunnawal country? Let's explore Australian waterways and create our own coffee-antiqued river maps.		
Thu 24	It's a MASTERCHEF challenge today creating scrumptious snacks using BUSH food. We will learn about the natural resources and elements of bush tucker and how to use them in our every-day cooking.
